Foreword.

Steven Weigl is extremely indebted to Lousie Howes Burnett, Howard I. Durie, and Frederick W. Bogert for their Documentary Collection Guide completed in 1966. This guide was consulted and the compilers format was replicated and used extensively to complete this latest GUIDE TO THE MANUSCRIPT AND DOCUMENT COLLECTIONS.

As stated in the Foreword of the original guide, "It has seemed best to separate the collection into two groups - the Manuscript collection and the Miscellaneous Collection."

The Manuscript Collection, due to the fragility and uniqueness of the collection, is stored interlaced with Bond paper, and other protective material. This collection is more restricted in availability, with the new index providing much information. This collection follows a numerical format. Certain aged or dated Manuscripts found in the Miscellaneous Collection are presently located in the Manuscript Collection.

The Miscellaneous Collection is not as restricted and is available to the public. This collection is filed according to subject matter, and follows an alphabetical format.

To confirm numerical identification each document and manuscript was meticulously verified for accuracy as listed in the original Guide.

The numbering system, although maintained, has been improved with occasional numerical and alphabetical modifications. These changes should make the latest Guide more user friendly.

The Index was compiled through examination of each Manuscript. The Card File numbering system that was previously used for the Manuscript Collection did not include these manuscripts. This card file is now obsolete.
