Starting at the Southwest corner of the property entering through the chain link fence gate: Each row was cataloged by going South to North and progressing row by row in an easterly direction.

There are many graves including ones place by the VA that we do not believe are in the correct locations based on location of footstones. Many of the headstones are unearthed and leaning against tree trunks, under or against fencing. Any stones that were in danger of being removed from the site by vandals were recovered to a safer location within the site.
